

*Disclaimer: Although we have had no reported problems with this, we always recommend that you back up your sat nav before making any changes to it. Cask Marque accepts no liability for any problems which may occur.*

To get the Cask Marque outlets you first of all need to download a POI loader onto your PC. This can be found on the net under

[www.garmin.com/products/poiloader](http://www.garmin.com/products/poiloader)

Download this file to a folder on your PC.

Then download Cask Marque's files:

[caskmarque.csv](#) (this is a list of pubs and coordinates) and

[caskmarque.bmp](#) file (this is the Cask Marque logo and will appear against the pub at the location).

Note firstly, Garmin will only work on the csv and bmp files - do not try to load the ov2 file as it won't work. Secondly, it is very important when you load down the files from Alastair to put them in a totally separate folder on your PC. We suggest you create a new folder for these.

Open the Garmin POI folder which you downloaded earlier and follow instructions to download the folder that contains the Caskmarque csv and bmp files.

Ensure the Sat nav is connected to your PC via a USB socket and proceed to download the files.

The files will be loaded and can be found under 'Where to? / Extras' on your Garmin Sat nav.
