

*Disclaimer: Although we have had no reported problems with this, we always recommend that you back up your sat nav before making any changes to it. Cask Marque accepts no liability for any problems which may occur.*

Firstly Navman users need to obtain a kit obtainable from Navman consisting of a cable to link the satnav to a pc plus a disk with software. When I bought mine via Navman's website just over a year ago the cost was just under £18. This software allows the user to upload to the satnav other POI files, e.g. from hotel chains, as well as updated maps from Navman.

Then, after downloading the csv and bmp files to your pc the actions are:-

1. Leave Navman switched off.
2. Connect Navman to pc with cable.
3. Switch on Navman.
4. Start up the software (F-Series Desktop).
5. On the Desktop software click on "File" in the top toolbar, then "Open text file".
6. A window opens. Find the directory in which the downloaded files have been saved and select the csv file.
7. Click on "File" in the top toolbar, then "Save to device".
8. A new window opens and the default POI file name is "CASKMARQ", which can be changed if desired.
9. To select the downloaded bmp icon file click on the "Browse" button to "point" to the bmp file.
10. Click on "OK" and when in the next window click on the "Copy POI" button.
11. A final window appears with the message "POI file has been successfully downloaded to your device". Click the "OK" button.
12. Close the Desktop software.
13. Switch off the Navman satnav.
14. Disconnect the cables.

15. The POI file should now be ready for use and will be shown with the title "CASKMARQ".
