

## Win a £50.00 Bar Tab Competition Terms and Conditions

### **1. Promoter**

The promoter is The Cask Marque Trust Ltd (company number 03491957) (“the Promoter”), the operator of the Cask Finder app.

### **2. Eligibility**

2.1 The competition is open to individuals who:

- (a) are aged 18 years or over;
- (b) are resident in the United Kingdom; and
- (c) hold a valid user account on the Cask Finder app.

2.2 Employees, consultants, contractors, agents of the Promoter or its sister companies, and their immediate family members or household members, are excluded from winning, but may participate unless otherwise prohibited.

### **3. Competition Period**

The competition will run from 11:00 on 4 February 2026 to 23:00 on 14 February 2026 inclusive (“Competition Period”).

### **4. How to Enter**

- 4.1 To enter the competition, eligible users must submit a beer rating in a Cask Marque, Beer Marque or Perfect Pint Promise pub via the Cask Finder app during the Competition Period.
- 4.2 Each beer rating submitted during the Competition Period will automatically generate one entry into the prize draw.
- 4.3 Only one prize may be won per person, regardless of the number of ratings submitted.

### **5. Prizes**

- 5.1 There are ten (10) prizes available. Each prize consists of a £50.00 bar tab (“Prize”).
- 5.2 The Prize will be paid directly to an accredited pub selected by the winner from those in which they submitted an eligible beer rating during the Competition Period.
- 5.3 The Prize may only be redeemed in accordance with the chosen pub’s licensing conditions and policies.
- 5.4 The Prize is non-transferable, non-exchangeable and non-refundable, and no cash or alternative payment will be offered.

### **6. Prize Draw and Selection**

- 6.1 Winners will be selected at random from all valid entries after the close of the Competition Period.
- 6.2 The Promoter’s decision in relation to all matters concerning the competition is final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into.

### **7. Winner Notification**

- 7.1 Winners will be notified by email using the address associated with their Cask Finder account.
- 7.2 The Promoter will make up to two (2) attempts to contact each winner.
- 7.3 If a winner does not respond within 14 days of the second notification email, the Promoter reserves the right to withdraw the Prize and award it to a reserve winner.

### **8. Prize Fulfilment**

- 8.1 Winners will be required to confirm their chosen pub for redemption of the Prize.
- 8.2 The Promoter will arrange payment of the bar tab directly with the selected pub.

8.3 The Promoter accepts no responsibility for a pub's refusal or inability to honour a bar tab due to licensing restrictions, closure, or other circumstances beyond the Promoter's control.

### **9. Data Protection**

9.1 Personal data provided by entrants will be processed solely for the purposes of administering the competition and awarding the Prizes, in accordance with the Promoter's Privacy Policy.

9.2 Where necessary for Prize fulfilment, personal data may be shared with third parties strictly for that purpose.

### **10. Limitation of Liability**

The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, or disappointment suffered by entrants as a result of entering the competition or accepting a Prize, except where liability cannot be excluded by law.

### **11. General**

11.1 The Promoter reserves the right to substitute the Prize with an alternative of equal or greater value where circumstances beyond its control make this necessary.

11.2 The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, suspend, or amend the competition or these Terms and Conditions at any time without prior notice.

### **12. Relationship to App Terms**

This competition is subject to, and must be read in conjunction with, the Cask Finder App Terms and Conditions. In the event of any conflict, the Cask Finder App Terms and Conditions shall prevail.

### **13. Governing Law**

These Terms and Conditions are governed by English law, and any disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
